The purpose of the meetings is to help Ukrainian conservatives better understand the current challenges in contemporary social and political life.

The Conservative Dialogues are non-partisan and provide a unique opportunity to establish business relationships and cooperation across the conservative spectrum.

Objectives:

- - creation of a common space for meetings and search for unity with Ukrainian and foreign conservative thinkers;
- - a clear formulation of the modern Ukrainian conservative values platform with further theoretical development and its practical application.

Topics of the meeting:

- The war in Ukraine;
- Conservative vision of Ukraine: value system - its balance and hierarchy
- Geopolitical future of Ukraine;
- International cooperation with conservative parties and organisations – current challenges, vision and common interests;

- Freedom as a culture of duty and responsibility;
- Res Publica as securing equal opportunities for citizens in decision-making and implementation of the rules of common life;
- Citizenship as a dynamic participation in public affairs;
- Reproduction of the social structure of society and the process of forming elites;
- The role of the family in its social functions and social subjectivity;
- Demographic policy;
- Education, science, culture - their value load and essence, weight and significance in social and historical processes.

The Conservative Dialogues will be held on a regular basis - monthly in each region of Ukraine by turns.

They will discuss certain aspects of conservative ideology and its impact on technology, environment, identity, family relations, civil society, and its legal and moral and ethical foundations.
